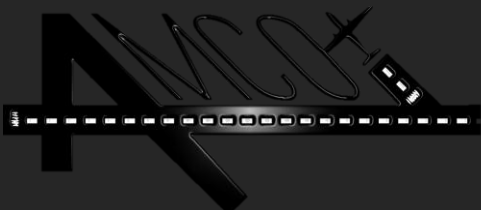
- AMCO monitors developments within the airport industry, communicates this information to you, actively lobbies

Training

- In 2006, web based occupational health and safety training was introduced. The cost is a fraction of the budget needed to send employees off site for training. The platform offers numerous modules including courses such as Safety Orientation, WHMIS, Fire Safety Training, Lockout/Tagout Training, Workplace Inspections, Safety management Systems, Airside Vehicle Operators Permit, and Due Diligence.

AVOP Online Training:

- This course will give successful students a sound understanding of the regulatory and safety issues associated with operating a vehicle air side. Upon completion, a certificate will be issued to your account immediately which you will be able to print. If for some reason you lose your certificate, replacements may be printed at no extra cost from within your account.

IATA - 2011 (TDG AIR):

- This comprehensive "TDG by Air (IATA) Online Training Program" follows Transport Canada Aviation's Training Advisory "TP 12208" which specifies the "Guidelines and References for the Development and Standardization of Dangerous Goods Training Programs for Air Transport".

SMS 101

- SMS 101 is a comprehensive, 10-module SMS implementation training program. This course is a simplified, common sense approach to the most up-to-date SMS regulatory requirements. It provides basic tools, templates and examples to assist staff at all levels with developing and implementing SMS within their organization. The SMS 101 program meets or exceeds all Canadian Aviation Regulations requirements along with FAA, CASA, EASA, ICAO standards and regulations.

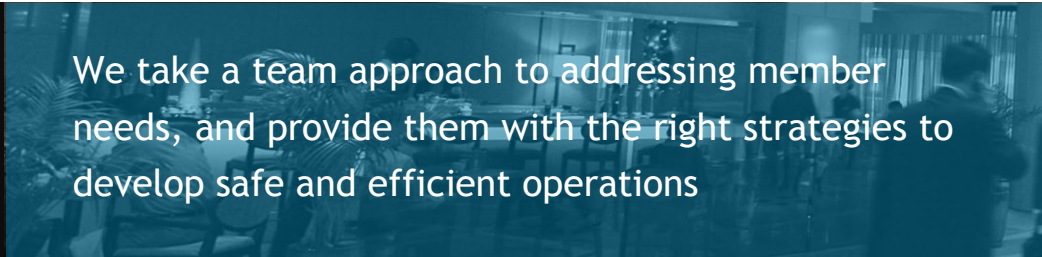
