The Pembroke & Area Airport, located in Petawawa, is one of five certified airports in Eastern Ontario. Located in Petawawa, the Airport serves approximately 3,500 aircraft movements each year. The Airport interacts with many agencies in the course of daily work including the Government of Canada, the Department of National Defence, the Ministry of Natural Resources (Ontario and Quebec), Ornge (air ambulance), Canadian Coast Guard and many private pilots and aircraft. We are a critical base of operations during forest fire season, we facilitate emergent medical transfers and we provide services that aid in search and rescue operations.

The Airport is currently recruiting for Airfield Operators. We welcome applications for part-time and full-time positions and are flexible in accommodating schedules. As the airport operates seven days a week, we can accommodate weekday and weekend opportunities.
