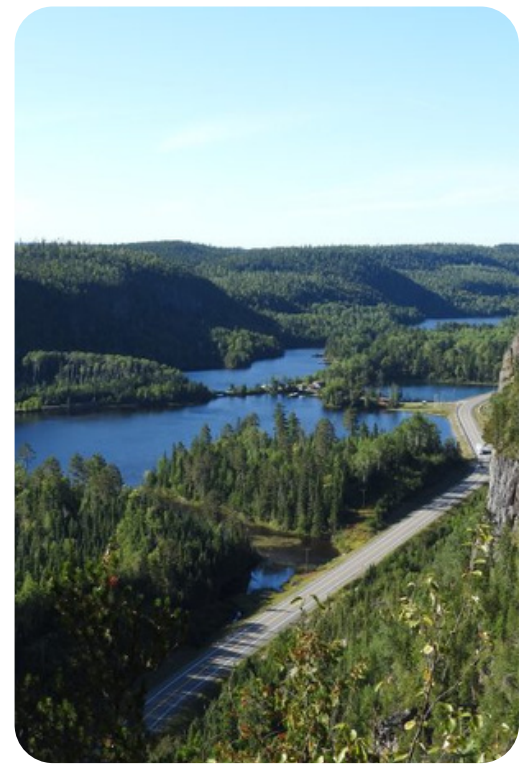
- Grade 12 secondary school education
