Duties and Responsibilities include:

- Execute work program in accordance with Transport Canada regulatory requirements and industry best practices, including emergency response, wildlife management, winter maintenance and the operation of all aerodrome maintenance equipment
- Operate heavy equipment including tractors and attachments, loader, backhoe, snow blower, sweeper, and single and tandem axle trucks for winter and summer maintenance activities including grass cutting, vegetation control, and snow clearing
- Perform minor maintenance of airfield equipment in a safe and professional manner
- Use of and minor maintenance on chainsaw, hand, and power tools
- Minor and preventative maintenance of airfield electrical systems including replacing airfield ground lighting fixtures, wind direction indicators, pull-pit preventative maintenance and fixture preventative maintenance
