Heavy Equipment Operator Trainer Airport industry – Northern environment

Summary

Octant Aviation Inc is looking for 2 heavy equipment operator trainers for the Kativik Ilisarniliriniq School Board located in Northern Quebec Nunavik. It is a contractual position for a 5-month period. The trainer's main goal is to bring the operators, under his instruction, to acquire the following competencies:

- Gravel runway maintenance and repair
- Operating a grader, compactor, snowblower, and loader within airport restricted areas
- Maintain runway surfaces, maneuvering areas, and airport access roads
- Ensure appropriate compaction and crown on runway
- Perform snow removal operations and required winter maintenance of movement areas and airport grounds
- Ensure navigational aids are functioning as required
- Evaluate and report runway condition to the NAV Canada Flight Information Center (FIC)
- Perform inspection reports on the serviceability of airport heavy equipment
- Ensure transfer of knowledge of Transport Canada regulations including but not limited to, SMS, Wildlife, airside vehicle operations, & emergency response.



Requirements

- Significant experience as an airport equipment operator trainer
- Must ensure safety regulations and procedures are upheld
- Valid Class 5 driver's license
- A restricted radio operator's certificate (ROC-A)
- Proficient in English
- Able to share knowledge with enthusiasm
- Adaptable person able to work independently with minimal supervision
- Able to travel in Northern isolated regions for up to six weeks at a time
- Possess excellent communication and listening skills
