#### Summary of Duties:

Reporting to the Supervisor, Maintenance and Airfield Operations performs maintenance and repairs of airport vehicles and equipment in accordance with Department of Transport Standards.

#### Specific Duties:

##### Mechanic

- Diagnoses trouble and tests equipment such as snowplows, fire trucks, dump trucks, tractors, sweepers and related mobile equipment.
- Inspects and services vehicles and equipment on a scheduled basis.
- Operates shop and power tools such as hydraulic jacks, hoists, electric drills, air power wrench and welding equipment.
- Dismantles, adjusts, repairs, and reassembles engines, transmissions, clutches, rear ends, differentials, drive-shafts, axles and related parts.
- Installs repairs and removes ignition systems, generators, alternators, starters, coils, instrument wiring and other electrical equipment.
- Repairs and adjusts fuel systems and performs complete engine tune-ups.
- Repairs, replaces and adjusts vehicle pneumatic and hydraulic systems.
- Diagnoses, repairs and overhauls steering and suspension and brake assemblies.
- Repairs small equipment such as lawnmowers, weed eaters and water pumps.
- Diagnoses and repairs problems with vehicles in adverse weather conditions.
- Attaches and detaches accessory pieces of equipment such as snowplows, sweepers and agricultural type equipment.
- Completes records of servicing including materials used and labour.
- Complete monthly inventory.
- Contacts and arranges with outside companies for warranty and repair work.  
Obtains pricing/quotation from suppliers and maintains parts inventory
- Performs other duties as assigned which are related to the major responsibilities of the job.
- Maintain good/open interaction with fellow employees with a professional service oriented attitude.

#### Qualifications:

- Must have and maintain a valid Ontario Truck and Coach Technician License (310T) and a valid Automotive Service Technician License (310S).
- Must be able to weld and use torches.
- Must be capable and willing to maintain technical currency on company vehicles and equipment.
- Must be willing and able to maintain other endorsements as may be required by the Department of Transport in the future.
- Must possess Ontario Driver's License Class DZ or equivalent.
